

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A water-based spray [roll-in] to protect horses from biting midges, deer flies, fleas, gnats, horse flies, houseflies, mosquitoes, stable flies and ticks.

**As A Horse Spray:** To control biting midges, deer flies, fleas, gnats, horse flies, houseflies, mosquitoes, stable flies and ticks, spray a light mist, at a rate of 1 to 2 ounces, over the entire body area where generally attacked by these insects. Do not saturate hair or skin and avoid animal's eyes and mouth. Do not repeat application more than once per day.

**As A Roll-On:** To control biting midges, deer flies, fleas, gnats, horse flies, houseflies, mosquitoes, stable flies and ticks, apply approximately 1 to 2 ounces over the entire body area where generally attacked by these insects. Do not saturate hair or skin and avoid animal's eyes and mouth. Do not repeat application not more than once per day.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled, with an effective cleaning compound and rinse with potable water to remove all traces of contamination. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### Statement of Practical Treatment

**If Swallowed:** Call a physician or poison control center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or if available, by administering syrup of ipecac. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. **If Inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. Get medical attention. **If In Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **If On Skin:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic animals. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
