

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- General Classification.
- It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
- Remove hot rocks, caves and other cage furniture items (including substrate) from your terrarium.
- Spray above items with *Wipe Out 2* and let sit for 5 minutes. Wipe items clean with a slightly damp cloth or paper towel and return furniture to terrarium.
- Substrate: spray as above and let sit for 5 minutes. Place in bucket of clean water and "swish" for 15-30 seconds. Wring out or thoroughly air dry. Return to terrarium.
- Animals frequently defecate on hot rocks and other cage furniture items inside your terrarium. This can result in high bacteria and ammonia levels which can lead to possible infection/disease in your animals. When used regularly, *Wipe Out 2* can eliminate these high bacteria/ammonia levels on your cage furniture items.
- **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse container with water and discard with trash.
- **REPLACEMENT:** substrates for desert terrariums (i.e. sand or gravel) must be completely dry before returning to terrarium to avoid high humidity levels. Always replace substrate if a foul odor persists.

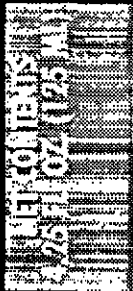
