

DI-BOR is an odorless, colorless treatment to stop wood decay fungus (wet and dry rot) in wet and dry boats and all home construction. Can be used in new construction and applied liberally to existing boats and home areas.

DI-BOR penetrates to the deep interior of wood but does not effect painting, staining, gluing or the machining properties of the wood.

Application Tips

Pay particular attention to rot prone areas, such as the stem, keel, chine areas, windshield corners, anywhere two pieces of wood come together. On houses, check basement or crawl space areas, roof beams, or any area where new wood is being installed.

The wetting process may need to be repeated several times to achieve maximum penetration. Application may also be made by drilling holes and injecting the solution directly into the wood.

Di-Bor may be irritating. Consider wearing a dust mask and eye protection, long sleeve shirt and long pants, chemical resistant or waterproof gloves, shoes and socks.

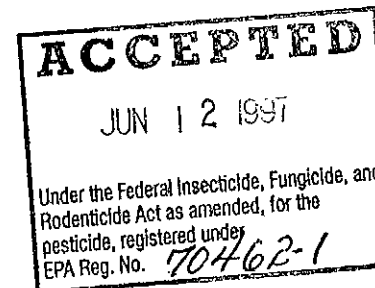

1. Fill this container with warm water until approximately 3/4 full.
2. Shake to mix thoroughly.
3. Fill remainder with warm water to top.
4. Apply to wood surfaces with paintbrush, garden-type pressure sprayer, or dip wood into warm solution and soak for 5 minutes. Application may also be made by first drilling then injecting the solution directly into the infested area.
5. The wetting process may need to be repeated several times over a 24 hr. period to achieve maximum penetration.

Coverage 100-150 sq. ft. per gallon depending on wood porosity.

Residue can be washed off with warm water.

This product is toxic to wood destroying insects but surface etching of treated wood may occur.

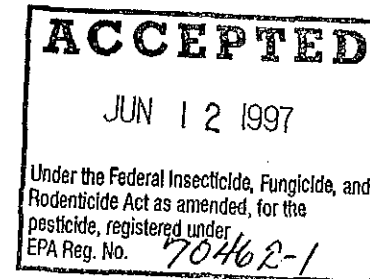
