BUILDINGS, THEATERS, GARAGES, HOTELS, MOTELS AND KENNELS

ATTACH EXTENSION TUBE TO SPRAY ACTUATOR:

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS & CRICKETS: Spray on floors along
baseboards in the kitchen and baths. Special attention should be paid to areas
around refrigerators and entry points such as doors, windows, vents, pipes, etc.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS (mosquitoes, houseflies and gnats): Close space to
be treated. Spray above head with a sweeping arm motion 3 feet from surfaces.
Spray 10 grams (10 seconds) per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep treated areas
closed for at least 30 minutes after spraying. Ventilate area before re-entry. Repeat
as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS AND
SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly
spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention
should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks and behind
refrigerators.

TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old
bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door
frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary.

DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS: Old bedding should be removed and replaced with
clean fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea
and tick control product before allowing them to enter the treated area.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and
discard in trash.
