

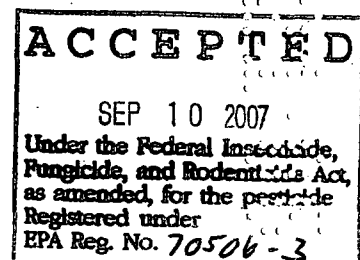

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to birds.
