CONTROL OF CRABGRASS OR GOOSEGRASS: Application should be made 2-3 weeks prior to weed emergence. Apply using a shaker canister, flow drop or a cyclone type spreader. A more uniform application can be made by spreading half the required amount over the area to be treated, then applying the remainder at right angles.
