This turf fertilizer product contains Gallery® and Surflan® preemergence herbicides for control of certain broadleaf weeds and annual grasses in established warm season turfgrasses. Apply in late summer to

early fall, approximately 3 weeks prior to the expected germination of winter annual weeds, or in early spring, 3 weeks prior to germination of weeds that emerge in spring or early summer.

This product will not control established weeds. Areas to be treated should be free of established weeds or controlled with postemergence herbicides. To insure optimal fertilizer and herbicidal response, water treated areas as soon as possible after application. A single rainfall or sprinkler irrigation of 0.5 inch or more is required to activate this product.

- Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.
- This product must be watered in as soon as possible after application to dissolve the granules. A single rainfall or irrigation of ½ inch or more is required after product application.
