2. Revise "Precautionary Eye Statements" as follows:
a. Revise the first sentence to read: "CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage."
b. Revise the third sentence to read: "Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing."
c. Revise the fifth sentence to read: "Do not breathe vapor."
d. Add the following statement: "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, and using tobacco."
