Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water food or feed by storage or disposal

Pesticide Storage Store in original containers only. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near food or feed. In case of spill on floor or paved surfaces, mop and remove to chemical waste storage area until proper disposal can be made if product cannot be used according to label.

Pesticide Disposal Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous Improper disposal of excess pesticide spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Protection Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance

Container Disposal Triple rinse (or equivalent) Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Clean container promptly after emptying.

Triple rinse [or pressure rinse] as follows

Triple rinse Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container back on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use and disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Do not cut or weld.

Pressure rinse Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank affor continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after flow begins to drip. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities.

Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled Dike and contain the spill with inert material (e.g., sand, earth) Transfer liquid to containers and solid diking material to separate containers for recovery and disposal Remove contaminated clothing promptly and wash affected skin areas with soap and water Thoroughly launder clothing before re-use Do not take clothing home to be laundered. Keep spills and cleaning runoffs out of municipal sewers and open bodies of water. Refer to Precautionary Statements
