3. Change the signal word from WARNING to CAUTION.
4. Change statement in the Precautionary Statements from "May be fatal if swallowed." to "Harmful if swallowed."
5. It is recommended that you add the following PPE to the label: long sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes plus socks, and chemical resistant gloves.
6. In the Directions For Use section, add the following statement: "Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with US EPA requirements."


7. Change the statement "Only for formulation into an herbicide, for those uses being supported by United Phosphorus, Inc." to "INTENDED for formulation into an herbicide, for those uses being supported by United Phosphorus, Inc."

8. In the section STORAGE AND DISPOSAL, remove the word "Prohibitions." Remove "or cleaning equipment" from the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment. Move the statement "open dumping is prohibited" to the subsection "Pesticide Disposal."

Please note that the data requirements 830.6317 (storage stability) and 830.6320 (corrosion characteristics) are still outstanding and are to be submitted to the Agency upon completion, and no later than one year from the date of this letter.

You will submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.
