Do not apply more than 580 pounds of Bifenthrin 0.069 Insecticide with X-X-X Fertilizer per acre per year.

Apply this product directly to the lawn area. Water treated area as directed on this label. Do not water to the point of runoff.

Do not make applications during rain.

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Perimeter Application: Apply 3.33 to 6.66 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. to lawn areas 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the structure.

Lawn Application: Apply Bifenthrin 0.069 Insecticide with X-X-X Fertilizer with suitable broadcast application equipment to ensure uniform coverage over the treatment area. Apply 3.33 to 6.66 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. to control the following insect pests:

In New York State, this product may NOT be applied to any grass or turf area within 100 feet of a water body (lake, pond, river, stream, wetland, or drainage ditch).

In New York State, do make a single repeat application of Bifenthrin 0.069 with X-X-X Fertilizer if there are signs of renewed insect activity, but not sooner than two weeks after the first application.
