Lawn Application: Apply Bifenthrin 0.069 RU with X-X-X Fertilizer with suitable broadcastre application equipment to ensure uniform coverage over the treatment area. Apply 3.33 to 6.66 compounds per 1,000 sq. ft. to control the following insect pests:
