#### LAWN AND PERIMETER APPLICATIONS

Perimeter Application: Apply 2.75 to 5.5 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. to ground areas 6 to 10 eee wide around and adjacent to the structure.

Lawn Application: Apply Bifenthrin 0.083 Insecticide with X-X-X Fertilizer with suitable broadcast application equipment to ensure uniform coverage over the treated area. Apply 2.75 to 5.5 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. to control the following insect pests:

In New York State, do make a single repeat application of Bifenthrin 0.083 Insecticide with X-X-X Fertilizer if there are signs of renewed insect activity, but not sooner than two weeks after the first application.
