Perimeter Application: Apply 3.13 to 6.25 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. to lawn areas 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the structure.

Lawn Application: Apply Bifenthrin 0.073 Insecticide with X-X-X Fertilizer with suitable broadcast application equipment to ensure uniform coverage over the treatment area. Apply 3.13 to 6.25 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. to control the following insect pests:
