On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is <u>conditionally</u> registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), provided that:

- 1. You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
- 2. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

Based on the acute toxicity for oral and primary eyes irritation (both Toxicity Category IV) you are not required to have an If in eyes or If swallowed first aid statement. You may delete them if you wish.

- c) Replace "The Directions for Use of this product should be followed carefully" with "The Directions for use of this product must be followed" in Warranty statement.
- d) Delete "golf courses" from the restriction "Not for Use on golf courses, sod farms ... etc" since the product is for use on golf courses.
- e) Replace "The Directions for Use of this product should be followed carefully" with "The Directions for use of this product must be followed" in Warranty statement. Also add the following qualifying language "To the extent consistent with applicable law", to the beginning of the bolded text, "United Phosphorus, Inc. makes ..." and "The exclusive remedy of the User ... etc"
- f) Under comments in pest table replace "eliminate" with "control".
- g) Combine together in a separate paragraph the statements beginning, "Not for use on turf being grown Etc, and, "Not for use on golf courses, sod farms ... etc".
- h) Add, "Do not apply by air" to the Directions for Use section.
- i) Add, "Do not apply within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries, and commercial fish farm pond" to the Directions for Use section.
- 3. There appears to be certain errors in the data matrix when recording MRID numbers for the acute toxicity. Refer to the enclosed review and correct and resubmit the data matrix for our records.
- 4. Please submit an one year storage stability study for the proposed product along with a corrosion characteristics study. We recommend that observation be made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 months intervals in the stability study.
- 5. Please submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Perimeter Application: Apply 3.13 to 6.25 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. to lawn areas 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the structure.

Lawn Application: Apply Bifenthrin 0.073 RU Insecticide with X-X-X Fertilizer with suitable broadcast application equipment to ensure uniform coverage over the treatment area. Apply 3.13 to 6.25 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. to control the following insect pests:
