This ready-to-use formulation of imidacloprid will kill subterranean termite species of Coptotermes, Heterotermes, Reticulitermes, and Zootermopsis. Formulated as a granule, this product may be used for perimeter band application and/or soil incorporated. When it has been applied to soil, moisture and/or precipitation will cause the active ingredient to release from the granule. The residue established in the top few inches of soil will kill termites present at the time of application. This product may be applied as a spot treatment in advance of structural treatment or treatment with a conventional soil-applied termiticide or foundation treatment.

USE SITES

Apply ImiBloc 0.5 G Termiticide/Insecticide to bare soils, landscaped areas, and turfgrass immediately surrounding sites such as residential structures, and other wooden structures which may be subject to termite infestations.

When infested areas are waterlogged, or soil beneath turf is saturated with water, avoid making applications because it is difficult to obtain thorough and consistent distribution of the product.

APPLICATION

Perimeter use (band application 3 to 10 feet wide around and next to the structure's foundation): To kill subterranean termites near commercial and residential structures, apply 1.8 lb ImiBloc 0.5 G (29 oz) per 1,000 square feet. For best results, irrigate the treated area (though not to the point of runoff) to move the active ingredient into the soil where termites forage.

Use standard granular application equipment (hand-held spreaders, shaker cans, wheel-mounted spreaders) to apply ImiBloc 0.5 G Termiticide/Insecticide uniformly. Calibrate the application equipment before use, and check frequently to ensure equipment is working properly to distribute the granules uniformly.

Soil incorporation: make spot treatments to kill termites in the soil. Incorporate the product into localized areas of soil along the foundation of structures, or in soil next to threatened wooden constructions. First dig a narrow trench (about 6 inches wide by 6 inches deep), then incorporate 1/6 lb (3.0 oz) ImiBloc 0.5 G Termiticide/Insecticide per linear foot of trench. Mix the product completely with the soil used to refill the trench. Or incorporate 1/3 lb (5.0 oz) ImiBloc 0.5 G Termiticide/Insecticide per square foot of surface at critical spots such as around plumbing, bath traps, utility services or wells/cisterns, and around poles or posts, fencing and decking materials, landscape timbers and similar non-structural places where wood comes into contact with soil.

United Phosphorus, Inc. herein submits a registration amendment for ImiBloc 0.5 G Termiticide/Insecticide (EPA Reg. No. 70506-75) consistent with the notification provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46.

This notification reflects the revision of the phrasing "for Commercial Use Only" on the front panel of the label. Per the US EPA Pesticide Labeling Consistency "For Use Only By" Issue Paper, dated October 24, 2006, this language is not enforceable and it is not appropriate to include on the label of a non-restricted use product any language limiting use to certified applicators. UPI has had at least one state reject our application for registration of this product based on this "commercial use only" language on the label. Therefore, UPI wishes to remove this phrasing from the ImiBloc 0.5 G Termiticide/Insecticide label. The sentence on the front panel of the label "For pest management professionals and commercial use only" will be replaced with verbiage already approved and found on the registered product labels of ImiBloc 4 F Termiticide/Insecticide (EPA Reg. No. 70506-168) and ImiBloc 70 DF Termiticide/Insecticide (EPA Reg. No. 70506-158). Specifically, the front panel of the label will now state "For use by" individuals/firms licensed or registered by the state to apply termiticide products. States may, have more restrictive requirements regarding qualifications of persons using this product. Consult the structural pest control regulatory agency of your state prior to use of this product."
