Products repackaged or reformulated using Imidacloprid 2 F MUP Insecticide will require registration with the Environmental Protection Agency. Only for repackaging or reformulation into an insecticide for the following uses:

- (1) Terrestrial Food and Feed Crops: Barley, Beets, Brassica Vegetables Crop Group, Canola, Cotton, Fruiting Vegetables Crop Group, Grapes, Hops, Leafy Greens Subgroup, Lettuce, Mango, Pecans, Pome Fruits Crop Group, Potatoes, Sorghum, Tomatoes, Turnip, and Wheat, Indoor Non-Food and Residential Uses, Greenhouse Non-Food Crop, Terrestrial Non-Food Crop, Residential Outdoor
- (2) Uses for which US EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration.
- (3) Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with US EPA requirements.

Detailed information on chemical and physical properties and other formulating recommendations for Imidacloprid 2 F MUP Insecticide are available upon request from United

Phosphorus, Inc. Obtain and read this information before undertaking the reformulation of Imidacloprid 2 F MUP Insecticide in order to avoid formulation hazards and insure a satisfactory finished product.

Labeling for products formulated from this product must conform to that which is currently registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Any variance from the federally registered labeling for products containing imidacloprid must be supported by data provided by the formulator.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry area, and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area. Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If the container is leaking or material is spilled for any reason or cause, absorb with sand or other inert material and dispose of absorbent in accordance with the Pesticide Disposal instructions listed below. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of the smoke.
