- 2. Per the acute toxicity review, the signal word section which includes DANGER and POISON must be revised to also include skull and crossbones symbol.
- 3. The heading "IF ON SKIN" appearing in the First Aid section must be revised to read "IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING."
- 4. As specified in the acute toxicity review, the text "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment" should be added to the Emergency Information section of the label.
- 5. The Agency recommends that additional text be added to the Note to Physician that addresses acute oral and eye irritation concerns.
- 6. Per the acute toxicity review, the text "Avoid contact with skin" must be added to the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statements currently on the label.

DANGER POISON
