


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1. Submit one copy of your final printed label 30 days from the date of this letter and before you release the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec.6 (E). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

2. Make the following labeling changes:

- On page 1, you must add the following statement after the Signal word.
"Si usted no entiende la etiqueta, busque a alguien para que se la explique a usted en detalle. (If you do not understand the label, find someone to explain it to you in detail).

- On page 1, add the following statement to the section that starts "Have the productfor treatment." "You may also contact 1800-xxx-xxxx for emergency medical treatment information."

- On page 3, the Precautionary Statement should read as follows:
"Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Wear protective eyewear such as goggles, face shield, or safety glasses. May be fatal if inhaled. Wear a dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH) approval number prefix TC-21C) or a NIOSH approved respirator with any N, R, P or HE filter. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Wear chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material such as polyethylene or polyvinyl chloride. Do not breathe dust. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

- On page 3 delete the Personal Protective Equipment section because manufacturing use products do not need it.

- On page 3, in the User Safety Recommendations section, first sentence add "and before" at the end of line and delete "Wash hands before" at the beginning of the second sentence, so that the two sentences are one sentence.

- On page 4, second paragraph of the Conditions of Sale and Limitation of Warranty and Liability section, the sixth line should read "Phosphorus, Inc, and Seller. To the extent consistent with applicable law all such risks shall be".
