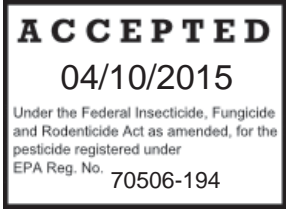

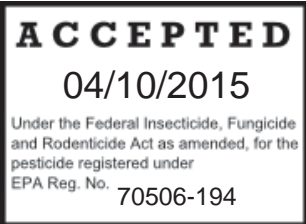

Do not apply this product with a U-boom device.</p>
