alfalfa, artichoke, asparagus, beans (edible), *Brassica* head and stem vegetables (subgroup 5-A), *Brassica* leafy greens (subgroup 5B), carrots, carrots grown for seed, cotton, citrus fruit (crop group 10), corn (field, pop, field seed, pop seed, fresh sweet), fallow, fruiting vegetables (crop group 8), garlic, grain sorghum, grape, Juneberry, leaf lettuce, leek, lentils and peas, melon subgroup 9A, mint (peppermint and spearmint), non-bearing citrus, non-bearing olive trees, nonbearing pome fruit, non-bearing small vine fruit (subgroup 13-07E), non-bearing fruit, non-bearing tree nuts, non-bearing vineyards, olive, onion (green, dry bulb), peanuts, perennial grasses grown for seed, pistachio, pome fruit (crop group 11), pomegranate, potatoes, rice, shallots (green, dry bulb), small vine fruit (subgroup 13-07E), soybeans, strawberry, stone fruit (crop group 12), sugarcane, sunflowers, tobacco, tree nuts (crop group 14), turnip greens, vegetable soybean (edamame), wheat, Bermudagrass and other perennial warm season grasses, Christmas tree plantations, farmsteads, landscape or ground maintenance, ornamentals, turf grasses, and noncropland areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Clean promptly after emptying. Triple rinse or pressure rinse as follows.

Triple rinse: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

<u>Pressure rinse</u>: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 psi for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after flow begins to drip.

Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities

Manufacturing Chemical: Do not ship or store with food, feed, drugs or clothing.
