The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

- 1) Alfalfa, artichoke, asparagus, bearing grape, Brassica head and stem vegetables, Brassica leafy greens, bushberry subgroup 13-07B, caneberry subgroup 13-07A, carrots, carrots grown for seed, Christmas trees, corn (field, seed, pop, pop seed, sweet), cotton, bearing and nonbearing olives, nonbearing nut trees, citrus fruit crop group 10-10, pome fruit crop group 11-10, stone fruit crop group 12-12, dry bulb onion subgroup 3-07A, edamame, edible beans, fruiting vegetables crop group 8-10, garlic, grain sorghum, grass forage/fodder/hay crop group 17, grasses grown for seed, green onion subgroup 3-07B, hops, Juneberry, leaf lettuce, lentils and peas, low-growing berry subgroup 13-07G, melons, mint, nonbearing fruit, nonbearing vineyards, peanuts, peas, pomegranate, potatoes, rice, soybeans, sugarcane, sunflowers (and other group 20B oilseeds), sweet lupines, tobacco, tree nut crop group 14-12, turnip greens, vine climbing small fruits, wheat, Bermudagrass and other perennial warm season grasses, landscape or ground maintenance, farmsteads, fallow, ornamentals, turf grasses, and noncropland areas.
- 2) Uses for which the U.S. EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration;

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Clean promptly after emptying. Triple rinse or pressure rinse as follows.

<u>Triple rinse</u>: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

<u>Pressure rinse</u>: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 psi for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after flow begins to drip.

Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities

Manufacturing Chemical: Do not ship or store with food, feed, drugs or clothing.
