The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Bifenazate Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must

submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to birds, estuarine/marine invertebrates, and fish. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area.

Rinsing application equipment over the treated area will help avoid run off to water bodies or drainage systems.

This product is moderately toxic to bees and other pollinating insects exposed to direct treatment or to residues in/on blooming crops or weeds. Protect pollinating insects by following label directions intended to minimize drift and to reduce pesticide risk to these organisms. Do not apply this product while bees are foraging the treatment area.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Keep unprotected persons and pets out of treated areas until sprays have dried.

KILLS:

A variety of mite species, especially spider mites, red mites and grass mites. This product is not effective against rust mites; broad mites and flat mites. **FLORAMITE® H&G** is primarily active on the motile stages of mites, but also has activity against spider mite eggs.

WHERE TO USE:

- All ornamental plants, including bedding plants, flowering plants, foliage plants, ornamental plantings, perennials, trees and shrubs.
- All non-bearing fruit trees which will not bear fruit for a minimum of 12 months.

Do not apply to fruits or vegetables used for food.

HOW MUCH TO USE:

Mix 1/4 – 1/2 teaspoons per gallon of water and apply as a full coverage spray to the foliage.

This product is to be applied using a hand sprayer. Read and carefully follow the instructions for the type of hand sprayer that is used.

DO NOT apply more than 3 applications per year (maximum yearly rate of 1.5 lbs ai per acre per year) for ornamentals.

WHEN TO USE:

Apply as soon as mites appear. An application can be made every 30 days up to 6 applications per year.

FLORAMITE H&G is not systemic in action; therefore complete coverage of both upper and lower leaf surfaces is necessary for effective control.

IMPORTANT

Neither the manufacturer nor the seller has determined whether or not **FLORAMITE H&G** can be used safely on all ornamental plants. **FLORAMITE H&G** has been tested on a variety of ornamental plants with no phytotoxicity observed at label rates. The user should determine the safety of **FLORAMITE H&G** by testing this product on a small number of plants. The end user assumes all risks arising out of application in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a dry location.

PESTICIDE CONTAINER HANDLING:
