It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not allow children to apply product. TO PREVENT HARM TO YOU AND YOUR DOG, READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE. FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAREFULLY. FOR EXTERNAL USE ON DOGS ONLY. DO NOT USE ON RABBITS. DO NOT USE ON OTHER ANIMALS.

Do not use on puppies under 8 weeks of age. [Do not split one tube between dogs.] [Do not use multiple tubes on one dog.] Weigh your dog to be sure you are applying the right dose formulated for the weight of your dog. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, or medicated dogs. Can be used on breeding, pregnant, or lactating dogs. Consult a veterinarian before using on dogs with known organ dysfunction. Dogs may experience some temporary irritation at the site of product application. 


