DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

BVA 2 Larvicide is for control of mosquito larvae in swamps, marshes, floodwater areas, drainage areas, waste treatment, settling ponds ditches and other manmade depressions.

BVA 2 Larvicide should be applied at the rate of 3-5 gallons per acre depending on how dense the vegetation and weeds may be.

BVA 2 Larvicide oil is noted for its water-white clear color and is also practically odorless.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS:

Do NOT contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited

STORAGE:

Store in a cool, dry locked place out of reach of children. Do not store near excessive heat or open flame.
