BVA 2 Larvicide is for control of mosquito larvae in swamps, marshes, floor water areas, drainage areas, waste treatment, settling ponds, ditches and other man-made depressions.

BVA 2 Larvicide should be applied at the rate of 3-5 gallons per acre depending on how dense the vegetation and weeds may be.

BVA 2 Larvicide oil is noted for its water-white clear color and is also practically odorless.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. **STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry locked place out of the reach of children. Do not store near excessive heat or open flame. Pesticide or pesticide waste rinse solution that cannot be used according to label must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state or local procedures or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse or equivalent. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
