**FIRST AID**

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

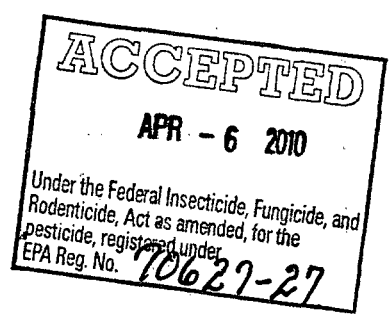

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A manufacturing use pesticide for use in commercial, institutional, and industrial equipment and settings or products for indoor food contact and non-food contact surfaces. Each repackager must obtain his/her own registration number and establishment number with the Environmental Protection Agency.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store in cool, dry well ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Protect from moisture contamination.

## PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. ### REFILLABLE CONTAINER
