Dear Ms. Amadio:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) The MRID you cited for efficacy purposes was only provisionally acceptable. You must add the statement "Sweep up and destroy fallen wasps and immobile spiders" because the knockdown and 24 hour mortality of your cited data was insufficient for a control claim.
- 2) As mentioned in our previous correspondence, please move the statement of "Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals" to your "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section (you have inadvertently deleted this statement).
- 3) Please revise your First Aid statement per PR Notice 2001-1 as follows:

**"IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."

You have inadvertently omitted part of your "If On Skin" statement.

## STORAGE & DISPOSAL

## SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

1) **OPEN** cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated. **REMOVE** or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and surfaces. **REMOVE** pets and birds, cover and turn off fish aquariums before spraying. Turn off air flow systems in aquariums. **COVER** waxed wood floors, waxed furniture and stereo or other plastic dust covers in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspaper may be used).

2) **CLOSE** outside doors and windows. **DO NOT** use more than one fogger per room. **DO NOT** use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off **ALL** ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e. refrigerator, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

3) Place a chair, table or stand in the center of the room to be fogged. Cover with several layers of newspaper, paper towels or plastic tarp.

4) **SHAKE CAN WELL.** Tilt sprayer **AWAY** from face (container sprays straight up). Press tab down in locked position.

5) Set fogger on covered stand. Immediately leave treated area.

6) Keep treated area closed for at least two hours. Before reoccupying area, open all doors and windows and allow treated area to air for 30 minutes.

In the home, remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or wash thoroughly before use. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Do not use in the food/feed areas of Commercial Food/Feed Handling Establishments, Restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Non-food/feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, closets, and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply this product only as specified on this label. Re-treat as needed.
