Do not reuse or refill this container. *If empty:* Offer for recycling, if available. *If partly filled:* Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain."



Shake before Use: Hold Container upright. Point spray opening away from face and press button.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats: Most effective when sprayed directly on flies. You can clear entire room in minutes by spraying upwards in sweeping movement (4 seconds for average room of 1000 cubic feet) staying about 3 feet from walls, fabrics and furniture. Keep doors closed for about 15 minutes. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate after treatment.
