FIRST AID Statement section comment(s):

1. The text "~~1-xxx-xxx-xxxx~~" in the existing 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence within the "**HOT LINE NUMBER**" subsection must be substituted with a phone number that is available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week for answering and responding to any medical emergencies or health concerns.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Shake before Use:** Hold Container upright. Point spray opening away from face and press button.

**Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats:** Most effective when sprayed directly on flies. You can clear entire room in minutes by spraying upwards in sweeping movement (4 seconds for average room of 1000 cubic feet) staying about 3 feet from walls, fabrics and furniture. Keep doors closed for about 15 minutes. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate after treatment.
