

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

CAUTION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State and Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATION: Confuse-PTB is intended for controlling the peach twig borer (*Anarsia lineatella*) by disrupting the mating of adult moths. For use on peaches, nectarines, apricots, plums, cherries or other stone fruit crops; almonds and other tree nut crops where the peach twig borer is a pest. Apply at a rate of 600 grams (30.0 grams of Active Ingredient equivalent) of formulation per acre. Apply Confuse-PTB early in the season or immediately after the first moth is detected in pheromone baited traps. Reapply Confuse-PTB as needed, based on local conditions, monitoring results, and field scouting. Do not exceed a total of 150 grams of Active Ingredient per acre per year.

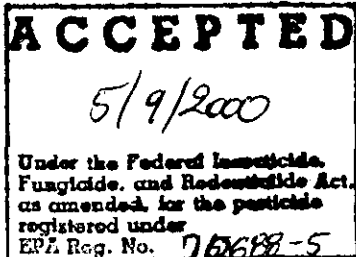
Apply Confuse-PTB evenly throughout the acreage to be treated. Apply the material in the upper one-half to one-third of the tree. Place the product on the bark of the upper branches of the tree. For example, if there are 100 trees per acre, place 6 grams of formulation (0.3 grams of Active Ingredient) per tree.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued)

Confuse-PTB should be applied in short toothpaste-like strips directly on the bark of the tree limbs. Several types of application devices are acceptable for dispensing this product in the field, e.g. forestry paint marking guns, paint ball guns, grease guns, etc. Therefore, the private or commercial applicator in charge of field applications will instruct as to the number of deposits per tree and the number of trees per acre necessary to treat to acquire the desired dosage per acre of the active ingredient.

Wash hands after applications. Do not handle other types of insect lures before or after lure placement without thoroughly washing hands. Monitor treatments carefully, especially for secondary pests such as leafrollers.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS
