DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Only for formulation into end-use repellent products registered by the formulator for use against mosquitoes, deer ticks, body lice, and biting flies.

Water- and alcohol-based formulations may be prepared by addition of various agents, such as emulsifiers or polymers to increase viscosity, prior to addition of water-insoluble IR3535®. Mixtures are usually homogenized and may be heated to 75°C and then cooled to promote development of stable suspensions. The inert ingredients (e.g., emollients, UV filters, neutralizers) may be added at various times during the process depending upon whether they are water soluble or insoluble.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a dry place away from extreme heat and cold (tightly closed at or below 59-77°F or 15-25°C). Keep container closed when not in use. In the event of spillage or leakage, soak up material with absorbent clay, sand, sawdust, or other absorbent material. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, if available. Or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities.
