Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: May cause moderate eye irritation. May cause skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- Long-sleeved shirt and long pants, Waterproof gloves, Shoes plus socks

This product is potentially pathogenic to honey bees. Avoid applying to areas where honeybees are actively foraging or around hives. DIRECTIONS FOR USE SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

For use in controlling darkling beetle in livestock/poultry production houses.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Do not use a fungicide prior to application of this product.

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Application Instructions

Each bottle contains approximately 15 fl. oz. of balEnceTM ES-Beetle, which treats 30,000 to 50,000 square feet of floor area. Apply balEnceTM ES-Beetle at a rate of 1.5 to 2 fl. oz. per 5,000 square feet of

floor area. Although balEnceTM ES-Beetle can be applied with conventional equipment of the user's choice, there must not be any filter or screen smaller than 50 microns, which would prevent the active ingredient from passing. Be sure to agitate the contents of the bottle by shaking vigorously to re-suspend any sediment that formed in the bottom. Add the contents of the bottle to sufficient water in a mix tank to ensure even coverage over the treated area. Add a small amount of water to the emptied bottle, replace the cap, and shake the bottle again. Add this "rinse" water to the mix tank.

Apply the spray to walls, floors, posts, where the greatest numbers of pests are located. This is a contact infection material. Re-treat between flocks or in areas where darkling beetles accumulate. There is no restriction on the total maximum amount of balEnceTM ES-Beetle that may be applied in a year. The product is only to be applied to poultry or livestock manure that is to be composted.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place in original container and out of direct sunlight. Do not store at temperatures exceeding 80° F (27° C).

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: To avoid wastes, use all material in this container by application according to the label directions. If wastes cannot be avoided, offer remaining product to waste disposal facilities or pesticide disposal program (often programs run by state or local governments or by industry).

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty remaining contents into application or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or mix tank or store for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure 2 more times. Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration. Do not burn, unless allowed by state and local ordinances.
