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SPACE SPRAY: To kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats. Close Seal all open vents. Remove fish and pets. Apply undilute electrical and other powered applicators. Avoid staining by mist toward the upper corners of the room. Fill the room with Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate thoroughly Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

CONTACT SPRAYS: To kill roaches, fleas, ants, crickets, millipedes - adjust spray to produce large wetting type sprays, floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets, and other necessary.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Apply as a spot treatment to cracks, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs. Then spot and seams. Repeat as necessary. For persistent infestation

TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS AND YELLOW JACKETS: Apply into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects

Extinguish all flames and pilot lights. Apply as a dry-fog at the thermal applicator toward the upper corners of the room and in treated areas. Ventilate.

OUTDOORS: To control nuisance pests around buildings, p Avoid spraying turf or plants.

Directions for killing ANTS, FLEAS, HORNETS, YELLOW JAK are the same as directed for indoor use.

To control named flying and crawling insects around premises entry. Also, thoroughly spray garbage and refuse areas, esp Do not spray on turf or plants.
