

MIXING DIRECTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Environ AW400 is ONLY to be used with the accompanying mixing directions and instructions. It is a violation of law to use this product without this literature. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

General Odor Control: Application rates may vary depending on amounts of organic matter, (sewage) in lagoons and pits. Application should be done by pouring Environ AW400 directly from the container into the pit or lagoon. Several application points speed up dispersal. Use 1 gallon of full strength Environ AW400 in 60,000 gallons (8,000 cubic feet) of sewage. For fastest results disperse Environ AW400 evenly throughout sewage. Odors should be noticeably reduced in 1-2 weeks. Repeat application when odors recur.

Feedlot Runoff Lagoons: Add a portion of the required dosage of Environ AW400 at several locations around the lagoon to speed dispersal of the product. A minimum of two applications per year (Spring & Fall) is recommended. Additional applications may be required as needed, or when the lagoon is pumped.

Animal Confinement Pits: If pits are located under the confinement buildings, add Environ AW400 directly to these pits. If the pits are outside, add Environ AW400 to transfer line to the pit.

Other Organic Sludges: Environ AW400 must be thoroughly mixed with sludge. Apply the rate of one gallon Environ AW400 in 30,000 gallons for sludge.

Other Odor Control: As an odor control for floors and walls use 1 oz. of Environ AW400 to six gallons of water and spray over affected area.
