

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with it's labeling.

General Algaecide/Algae Applications should be done by pouring POOL BLUE directly from the container into the swimming pool. Several application points spaced up dispersal. When visible algae is present, apply at the higher rate.

Start/Stop: Add 1 oz POOL BLUE Per 400 gal. pool water. That weekly maintenance amount for 10,000 gal. pool.

2) Run Pump and Filter full-time, backwash and clean filter each day for the first 2 days.

3) Clean or backwash filter every 2 weeks or as needed. Backwash or Start Service Contractors.

POOL BLUE will completely remove the red tide left by Sequestal & Soft Swim. Your water may turn brown or yellow. Clean your filter twice a day while maintaining a 1.0 PPM copper level. POOL BLUE & POOL GOO will remove these red tide within a few days.

Maintain with Copper Test KIT.

Maintain 0.5 - 1.0 PPM copper level. Water may cloud slightly upon initial introduction.

POOL BLUE may be used to control algae, bacteria & pond weed in swimming pools, hot tubs, spas, ponds & potable water supplies.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT:** Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

**DANGER - Corrosive.** Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear goggles or safety glasses. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or if absorbed through skin. May contain allergic skin responses. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:**  
Eyes: In case of eye contact, flush with plenty of potable water for at least 15 minutes and CALL A PHYSICIAN. If contact occurs, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Excess Pool Blue should be disposed of through use. Do not combine with water, food, or stored in this way unless fully full. Potable water use only. Hazardous: Improper disposal of excess product or empty container is a violation of Federal Law. If these vessels cannot be disposed of use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative of the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. In the event of a spill, notification with time of spill or leaking should be made. May defoliate concrete.
