

- 4. Delete the phrase on the center panel: "For Formulating Microbiostatic Agents, Fungistatic Agents, Deodorizers". This information is too broad. The uses of this product are clearly defined under the heading "Approved Uses".
- 5. Based on the presence of 12% Methanol in this product revise the "Precautionary Statements" to include the following: "Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled."
- 6. Delete the following statement under "Approved Uses": "BSTI 1860 is approved for use in formulating microbiostatic agents, fungistatic agents, and deodorizers for use in laundry additives, carpet, upholstery and drapery treatment products." The uses of this product are clearly defined within the information which follows this statement.
- 7. Add the following to the "Approved Uses" section of the label:



### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT


