STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water. Dilute by giving 1 or 2 glasses of water. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water for 5 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine Sulfate is antidotal. Start treatment by giving 2 mg atropine by injection after cyanosis is overcome and repeat atropine at 0.4 to 4 mg every 15 minutes until atropinization is achieved (tachycardia, flushing, dry mouth and mydriasis). Oximes such as 2-PAM/protopam are also antidotal, but only in conjunction with atropine. Observe to insure symptoms do not recur as atropinization wears off. Morphine, theophyllines, phenothiazines and reserpine are probably contraindicated. This product also contains lightweight aromatic hydrocarbons than can produce a severe pneumonitis if aspirated during emesis. Consideration should be given to gastric lavage with endotracheal tube in place. Treatment is controlled by removal of exposure followed by, , , , antidotal, symptomatic and supportive care.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container in secured dry storage area. Prevent cross contamination with other pesticides and fertilizers. Do not store above 100°F for extended periods of time. Storage below 32°F may result in formation of crystals. If product crystallizes, store at 72 to 90°F and agitate to redissolve crystals. If container is damaged or spill occurs, use product immediately or dispose of product and damaged container as indicated below. In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. If liquid, dike surrounding area or absorb spill with sand, cat litter, commercial clay or gel absorbants. If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinseate is a violation of Federal law.
