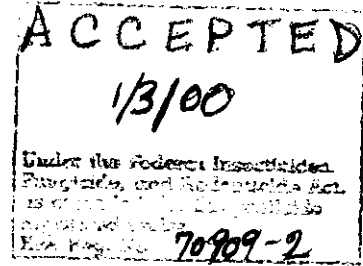



Nothing can ruin a backyard barbecue or pool party faster than swarms of mosquitoes. They are able to detect the scent of people from 100 yards away. When a mosquito picks up your scent, it zooms in for its next meal – ouch!

Now there is **mosquito 'cognito®**. It makes it harder for mosquitoes to find you. In independent tests at a Florida mosquito-breeding site during peak mosquito activity (the two-hour period beginning at sunset), **mosquito 'cognito®** reduced landings by as much as 68% for a human test subject seated at the water's edge. The protection you receive depends on the insect activity in your backyard.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When mosquito control is desired, open the **mosquito 'cognito®** dispenser and insert two AA batteries. Carefully peel off the foil covering from the replacement scent cartridge, being careful not to touch the contents, and place in the section of the dispenser below the fan. Close the cover and place the motorized dispenser on a flat surface. You are now ready to enjoy your outdoor activities. Use a dispenser for every 100 square feet (10 ft. X 10 ft.) of patio or deck. Replace after 15 days continuous use, or when fragrance diminishes.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Caution: Contents of replacement scent cartridges are harmful if swallowed or if directly inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid direct inhalation, or contact with eyes or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly after opening the replacement scent cartridge if contact with contents occurred.

First Aid

If swallowed: Administer water and call a physician or poison control center immediately. Do not induce vomiting.

If directly inhaled: Move person away from dispenser. Get medical attention.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of scent cartridges or dispenser.

Storage and Disposal

Cartridge Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry area.

Cartridge Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
