On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the following label changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Place your company address under your company name.
 - b. In addition to the metric units provided in the net contents section on page 1 of your label, you must provide English units.
 - c. The active ingredient section in the ingredients section must be modified to read 24.5% and the inert ingredients section must be modified to read 75.5% due to the purity of your source. Also add the statement "Contains 3.72 grams octenol." directly below the ingredient section.

- 2. d. Modify the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS heading so that it appears in capitalized letters and that it is moved directly above the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals heading.
- e. Modify the FIRST AID section so that it is above the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS heading.
- f. In the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section, modify "Avoid contact with skin and eyes." to read "Avoid contact of areas under foil wrapper with skin and eyes."
- g. Place the statement "For Outdoor Use Only" and the claim "Attracts Certain Mosquitoes and Other Biting Flies" on the octenol lure label.

3. Submit within six months data regarding the limits of detection, precision, and accuracy of the analytical method for octenol along with representative chromatograms.

4. Submit within six months octenol release rate data to support your claim that the octenol lure will last 30 days.

5. Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) that also lists the percent of pure active ingredient as 24.5% due to the purity of your active ingredient source. Your CSF dated 6/2/99 is the basic and only CSF approved for this product.


6. The sealed lure container described in MRID No. 444987-01 and tested for bite and crush resistance in MRID No. 444987-04 and octenol solubility in MRID No. 444987-05 must be used with all Dragonfly® Octenol Lures.

7. Submit five(5) copies of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. You must also submit the final labeling used for the dragonfly system for our files. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Disconnect the power supply and remove the bottom cover of the Dragonfly® Electronic Unit. Remove the Octenol Lure by depressing the clip that holds it in place. Peel away the foil wrapper and insert the replacement Octenol Lure through one of the two slots in the bottom of the unit. The Octenol Lure is asymmetrical and will insert in only one direction so that it is always properly positioned. Replace the bottom cover of the Dragonfly® Electronic Unit, connect the power, and turn the unit on. In every day use, the Octenol Lure will last 30 days.

Storage and Disposal

Store this product in a cool, dry place and out of the reach of children until ready to use.

Dispose of the used attractant lure by wrapping it in several layers of newspaper and dispose in the trash.
