

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

AQUA TABS are a slow dissolving form of calcium hypochlorite which provides a convenient source of available chlorine. It is recommended for use as a sewage effluent disinfectant and for other related applications where a continuous source of chlorine is required.

The amount of chlorine delivered will depend upon the flow rate of the water being treated, the amount of AQUA TABS being used and the configuration of the active bed of tablets. To provide an available chlorine concentration of 6 ppm will require about 1.4 pounds or six AQUA TABS for each 20,000 gallons of water treated. In practice, the number of AQUA TABS used should be adjusted to satisfy the chlorine demand and to maintain a proper chlorine residual. Measurement of the total available chlorine (combined plus free) in water treated with AQUA TABS is best accomplished by employing the iodometric titration technique (described in Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Waste Water, Sixteenth Edition, 1985, American Public Health Association, Inc. pp. 298-303).

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Strong oxidizing agent! Mix only with water. Use only a clean, dry utensil made of metal or plastic each time AQUA TABS are taken from the container. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination or decomposition, do not re-seal container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well-ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials before discarding this container. Do not reuse empty container but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal, or cleaning of equipment.
