c. Revise the "Environmental Hazards" statement to read:

Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

3. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTION FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

AQUA-70 tablets are a slow dissolving form of calcium hypochlorite which provides a convenient source of available chlorine. It is recommended for use as a sewage effluent disinfectant and for other related applications where a continuous source of chlorine is required.

The amount of chlorine delivered will depend upon the flow rate of the water being treated, the amount of AQUA-70 tablets being used and the configuration of the active bed of tablets. To provide an available chlorine concentration of 6 ppm will require about 0.8 pounds or three AQUA-70 tablets for each 10,000 gallons of water treated. In practice, the number of AQUA-70 tablets used should be adjusted to satisfy the chlorine demand and to maintain a proper chlorine residual. Measurement of the total available chlorine (combined plus free) in water treated with AQUA-70 tablets is best accomplished by employing the idometric titration technique (described in Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Waste Water, Sixteenth Edition, 1985, American Public Health Association, Inc. pp. 298-303).
