CAUTION. May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. **IF ON SKIN:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Active ingredient is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is an antidote.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to birds, fish and aquatic invertebrates. Fish and crustaceans may be killed if their waters are contaminated with this product. Birds feeding in treated areas may be killed. Clean up spilled product to reduce exposure to wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this pesticide or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

If disposal of a partially full container is necessary, make sure lid is tightly closed, securely wrap the container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

DIRECTION FOR USE: Use Only with THE SPRINKLELIZER SYSTEM®, Model #JB#12. To control insects we recommend to use one tablet for every 200 square feet of lawn or, start out with 4 tablets approximately once a week, or as needed for a period of 2 months. If your lawn is highly infested with insects and/or is extremely lacking nutrients, start with 5 or 6 tablets approximately once a week, or as needed. Then, as your lawn becomes rich, green, thick and insect free, we suggest 2 or 3 tablets each week or as needed. Before you reload new tablets into the feeder, empty and washout feeder then, flush system. If some remains of the tablet are present see Storage and Disposal directions.

Watering Tip: Early in the morning is ideal. We suggest to water your lawn everyday or every other day depending on your conditions of your lawn. Keep in mind, the key to effective watering is to give your lawn enough moisture to reach the roots of your grass. Do not over water your lawn. Midday watering when the weather is hot and dry, can waste water due to excessive evaporation. Evening watering tends to promote disease problems.
