Formulators using the product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products.

After March 1, 2012, the manufacturing use product may not be formulated into dry flowable end use products, unless the products are packaged in closed systems or unless the Agency has changed the dry flowable mitigation based on submitted data.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
