This produce may be used for experimental purposes that are in compliance with US EPA requirements. Formulators using the product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products.

After March 1, 2012, the manufacturing use product may not be formulated into dry flowable end use products, unless the products are packaged in closed systems or unless the Agency has changed the dry flowable mitigation based on submitted data.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not store this product near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides. Do not store near heat or open flame. Containers should not be stacked more than 3 units high. Reclose all partially used containers by tying bag top shut. Damaged or leaking containers, which contain product, that cannot be used immediately should be transferred to suitable sound containers and properly marked. Any spilled material should be thoroughly swept up and transferred to the new container or disposed of as indicated under 'Pesticide Disposal'.
