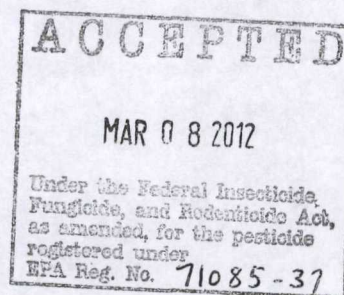

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Bags: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. ~~Clean container promptly after emptying.~~

For Bags: Completely empty ~~liner~~ bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into formulation equipment or mix tank ~~suitable container~~. Then dispose of ~~liner~~ bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. ~~If container is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.~~ If bag is burned stay out of smoke.

Triple rinse: To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container back on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use and disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Do not cut or weld metal containers.

Pressure rinse: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the

container, and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after flow begins to drip. Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities.

Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled: Scoop or shovel solid material into a suitable container for recovery or disposal. Remove contaminated clothing promptly and wash exposed skin areas with soap and water. Wash clothing before reuse. Keep spill out of all sewers and open bodies of water.
