Thoroughly vacuum carpet before treatment. Sprinkle "White Magic" Flea Carpet Treatment directly onto your carpet at the rate of one pound per 500 square feet of carpet. Use a broom to brush the powder into the carpet fiber. Do not vacuum for 5 days after treatment.
