It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product kills most germs, bacteria, and viruses. Kills *Salmonella choleraesuis* (Salmonella), *Staphylococcus aureus* (Staph) and *Streptococcus pyogenes* (Strep). This product kills household germs throughout the entire house plus prevents mold and mildew growth.

For use on hard non-porous environmental surfaces in homes, kitchens: cabinets, counter tops, drain boards, garbage cans, microwaves, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and under sinks; Bathrooms: bathtubs, closets, counter tops, waste baskets, hampers, tubs, toilet areas (seats, rims and exterior surfaces), plastic shower curtains, showers, tiled walls; General Use: chairs, closets, counter tops, damp storage areas, desks, diaper changing tables, diaper pails, door knobs; exercise equipment, faucet handles, living cabinets, garbage cans, pet areas, telephones and work benches.

**Sanitizes: Kills 99.9% of *Staphylococcus aureus* ATCC 6538 (Staph) and *Klebsiella pneumoniae* ATCC 4352 (K. pneumoniae) on hard, non-porous surfaces in 50 seconds.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS: This product is restricted for use on clean, hard, non-porous environmental surfaces in inedible product processing areas, non-processing areas and/or exterior areas. This product must not result in the direct or indirect contamination of food products. When used in microwaves and refrigerators and on food-contact surfaces, rinse treated surfaces with a potable water rinse after the required contact time. Do not use to mask odors resulting from unsanitary conditions.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: SHAKE WELL BEFORE AND DURING USE. Thoroughly clean surfaces or objects prior to application of product. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits. Safe for use on surfaces and fabrics except polished wood, rayon fabric or acrylic plastics.

To Disinfect: Spray 6 to 10 inches from clean surface for 3-4 seconds or until surface is thoroughly wet. Allow to dry without wiping or allow spray to contact treated surfaces for a minimum of 10 minutes prior to wiping.

To Sanitize: Spray 6 to 10 inches from clean surface for 3-4 seconds or until surface is thoroughly wet. Allow to dry without wiping or allow spray to contact treated surfaces for a minimum of 50 seconds prior to wiping.

For Herpes Simplex Type 2: Spray 6 to 10 inches from clean surface for 3-4 seconds or until surface is thoroughly wet. Allow to dry without wiping or allow spray to contact treated surfaces for a minimum of 10 minutes prior to wiping.

For Mildew: Clean surface then spray surface until thoroughly wet. Repeat weekly.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.
