 - d) Under Warranty Statement add "*To the extent consistent with applicable law*" in front of:
 - o "*In no case is Premium Environmental Products LLC liable for...*"
3. Please submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product

bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Containers can be used with ornamental and herbaceous plants and non-bearing fruit and nut crops normally grown in containers. Containers may be used at any stage in plant development from seedling to container grown shrub or tree. Containers should be filled with planting media, seeds or plants in the normal manner. No special preparation or handling is required.

TO USE: Containers are shipped in stacks. Remove container from stack and fill. Place into nursery production.

Do not allow children to play with these nursery containers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
