On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is **conditionally** registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) subject to the following provisions:

1. You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 71280-7."
 - b) This registration is limited to impregnated plastic nursery containers use only. Therefore, delete references to "plastic articles", "articles" throughout so the label reflects use for plastic nursery containers only.
 - c) Under Precautionary statements revise the 2nd sentence to read "...chemical resistant gloves." Also, add "and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse" at the end of the last sentence.
 - d) Add the heading "First Aid" and the following statements under the heading: "If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or a doctor for treatment advice".

- e) Immediately below the First Aid statement and clearly distinguished from it, add the following under the heading "Hot Line Number". Please refer to the boxed format example provided with PR Notice 2001-1: "Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-xxx-xxxx for emergency medical treatment information."
- f) Under Warranty Statement add "To the extent consistent with applicable law" in front of:
 - o "In no case is Premium Environmental Products LLC liable for..."
 - o "The exclusive remedy of the user or buyer for..."
- g) Delete the statement beginning "Nursery containers produced with Migratol BPX-002 are a USDA approved....etc." Language stating or implying that the product is recommended by any Agency of the Federal Government is unacceptable.
- h) Delete the statement beginning "Refer to the master label for the .5% and 1% ..." There is no master label associated with this application. Separate applications for registration have been submitted for the 0.5 and 1.0% formulations.

3. Product Chemistry data requirements for the 830 Series Subgroup A and Subgroup B guidelines are satisfied, except for the one year storage stability and the corrosion characteristic studies. Storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) data are outstanding and must be submitted to satisfy the requirements of 40CFR 158.190. Please refer to the Product Chemistry Review Memo for details concerning conduct of the studies.

4. The acute toxicity profile of this product has been determined to be as follows:

Acute Oral ----- IV	Primary Eye Irritation ----- IV
Acute Dermal --- IV	Primary Dermal Irritation --- III
Acute Inhalation --- IV	Skin Sensitization ----- Negative

We will waive the requirement for acute oral, acute inhalation, and primary eye irritation studies. We will extrapolate from data on the technical source for acute dermal and dermal irritation. Please submit an updated data matrix reflecting this change.

5. Please submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.


The basic and alternate confidential statements of formula (CSF) both dated 05/29/05 are acceptable. Copies of the CSFs have been placed in the file for the subject product.
